

# NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

Municipal Elections for the towns of: **Canton, Clyde and Maggie Valley** in

Haywood County will be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2017. The polls will be open for voting by those registered qualified voters eligible and residing inside the jurisdictional boundaries of above listed municipalities on that day from 6:30am. to 7:30pm.

Residents who are not registered to vote must register by; 5:00pm. October 13, 2017 to be eligible to vote in the municipal election. Also, a voter who has moved since the last election is encouraged to update any and all changes to registration records by that date.

A person may register to vote at the Haywood County Board of Elections at 63 Elmwood Way, Suite A, Waynesville, NC weekdays between 8:30am. and 5:00pm. or by mail-in voter registration application form that may be picked up at any branch of the Haywood County Public Library System. A person may also register to vote when receiving services or benefits from any government agency or affiliates that provide any public assistance or services. Any agency serving those with disabilities, Any division of employment such as all NC Work Career Centers, Armed Forces Recruitment Offices or the NC Department of Motor Vehicles. ## **(Original Signature Is Required for All Voter Registration Documents)**

Any eligible registered voter may vote absentee through one of two voting methods:

- 1) Voters may request at any time an application for a ballot to be mailed. Beginning October 6, 2017 applications for ballots requested will be processed and mailed by US postal service. The voter, the voter's legal guardian or the voters near relative must sign an application for a mailed ballot. Official NC Absentee ballot request forms must be received not later than 5:00pm. October 31, 2017.
- 2) Absentee voters who have an illness or physical disability expected to last through the calendar year may make a single request for all the ballots for that calendar year. Applications for ballots are available between November 1, 2017, 8:30am. and November 6, 2017, 5:00pm. Ballots must be returned to the Haywood County Board of Elections Office no later than 5:00pm. November 6, 2017.
- 3) Through the in person one-stop absentee voting method. Voters may use the in person one-stop absentee process offered at the Haywood County Senior Resource Center located at 81 Elmwood Way, Waynesville, NC. Beginning October 19, 2017, between the hours of 8:30am. and 5:00pm. weekdays and on Saturday November 4, 2017 between 8:30am. and 1:00pm.
